

Cutting Bracken Set

Violins

1. Buian na Rainich (Cutting Bracken) - 3x

1st time: 2 soloists trade 4 bars each. 2nd time: All violins tune

Two staves of music in 2/2 time. The first staff begins with a double bar line and repeat sign. The second staff continues the melody. The piece concludes with a double bar line and repeat sign.

3rd time: Some violins play 2nd part

Two staves of music in 2/2 time. The first staff includes first and second endings. The second staff continues the melody with first and second endings. The piece concludes with a double bar line and repeat sign.

2. Drummond Castle - 3x

1st time: Low register - Violas, cellos and some violins only if needed

Four staves of music in 6/8 time. The first staff begins with a double bar line and repeat sign. The second and third staves continue the melody with first and second endings. The fourth staff continues the melody with first and second endings. The piece concludes with a double bar line and repeat sign.

2nd time: Add 2nd part, some violins.

Four staves of music in 6/8 time. The first staff begins with a double bar line and repeat sign. The second and third staves continue the melody with first and second endings. The fourth staff continues the melody with first and second endings. The piece concludes with a double bar line and repeat sign.

3rd time: High register tune played by rest of violins (those not playing 2nds)

3. Cock of the North 2x

1st time: All violins play tune

2nd time: Some violins to 2nd part
