

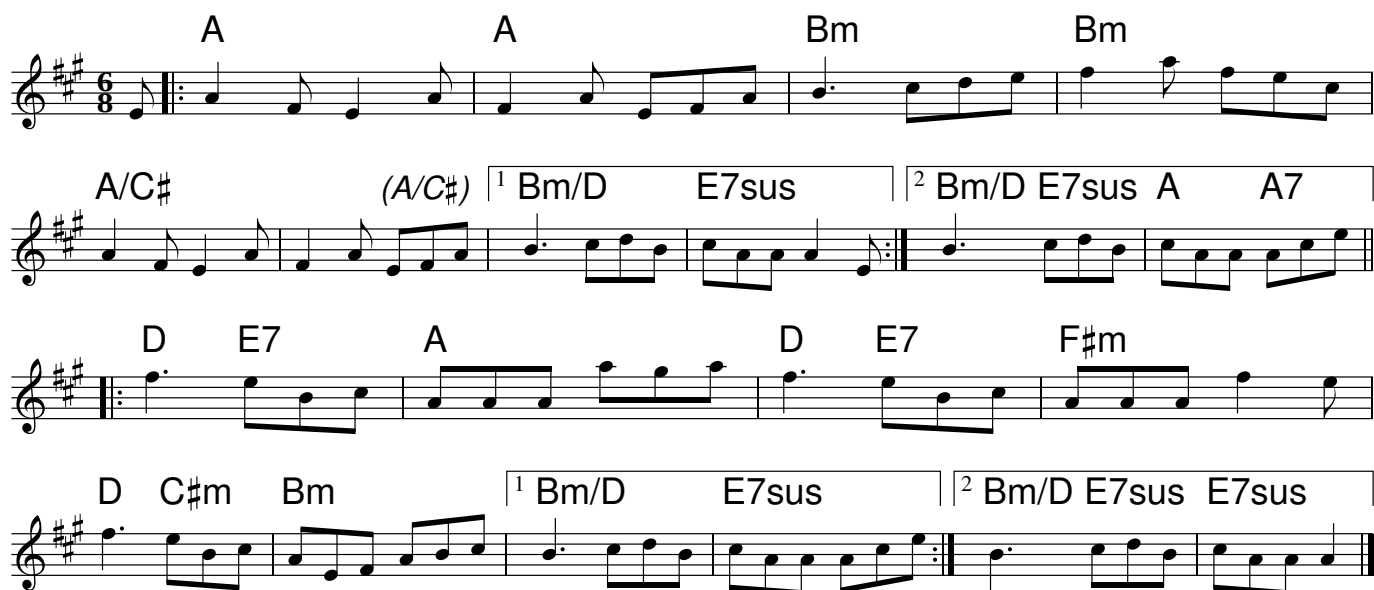

Option 1 - fewer chords

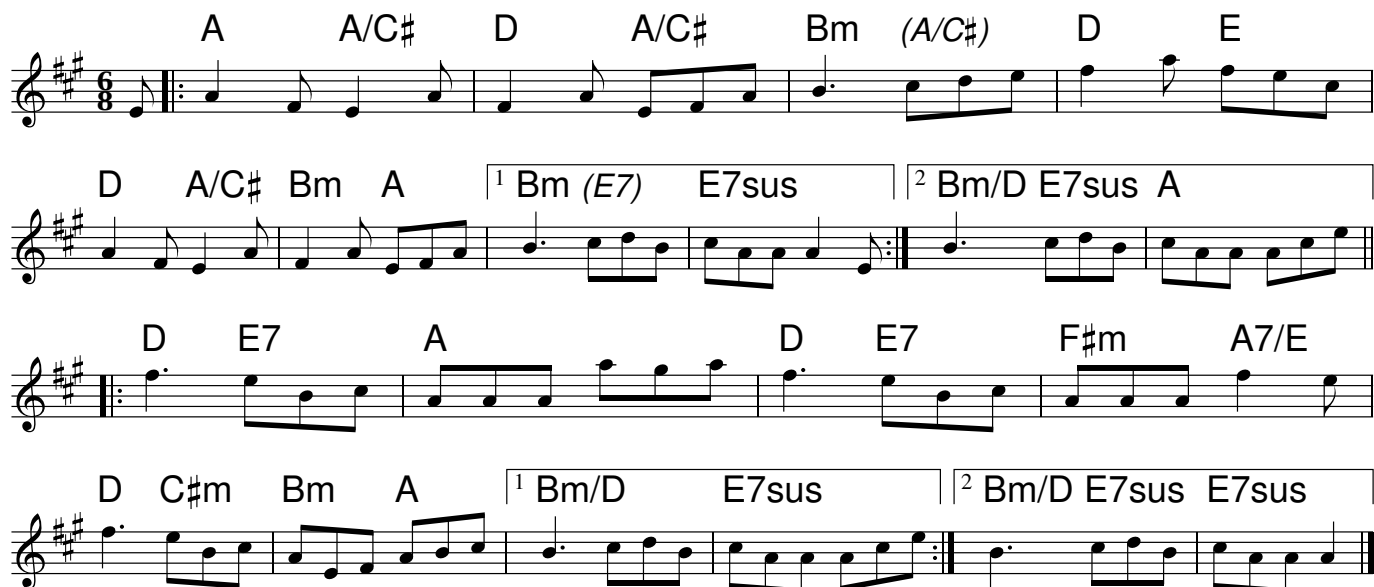
Good for cello and strummers
